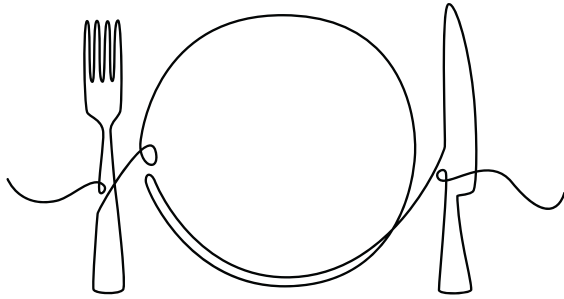

Harvest Dinner 2024

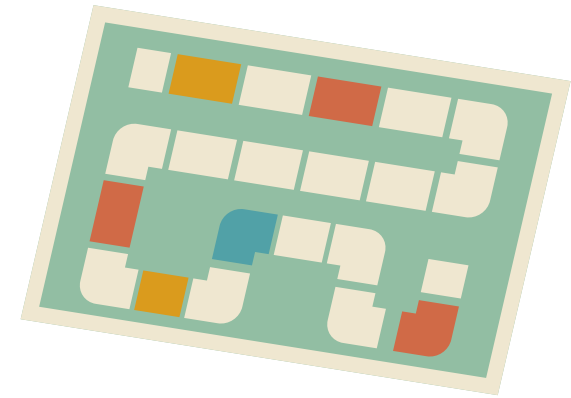
